Processing Techniques

This product is easy to process with standard injection moulding machines.

Following parameters should be used as guidelines:

Melt temperature Holding pressure Mould temperature Injection speed 220 - 260 °C 200 - 500 bar 15 - 60 °C High

Minimum to avoid sink marks.

Shrinkage 1 - 2 %, depending on wall thickness and moulding parameters

Storage

Bormed HD850MO should be stored in dry conditions at temperatures below 50°C and protected from UV-light. Following afore-mentioned conditions the material can be stored for a period of up to 3 years after production. Improper storage can initiate degradation, which results in odour generation and colour changes and can have negative effects on the physical properties of this product.
